Call for Nominations — 2026

Recognizing outstanding PhD research in scientific computing, numerical analysis, and related fields.

The Prize

- Formal recognition by the Dutch–Flemish Scientific Computing Society (SCS)
- Invitation to present the work at an SCS-related event

Eligibility

Defence: 16 June 2024–15 June 2026

- PhD awarded by a Dutch or Flemish university (including joint/double PhDs)
- Topic within scientific computing, numerical analysis or a closely related area

Submission Rules

- At most one nomination per university, with some flexibility in exceptional cases
- Nomination documents should be sent electronically by the nominee to:

using the subject line **Nomination SCS Prize**.

Nomination Documents

- Electronic copy of the PhD thesis
- Nomination letter from PhD supervisor
- Curriculum vitae
- List of publications

Optional: up to two additional support letters.
